Vivid ruby-red. A highly perfumed, exotic bouquet evokes ripe red berries, allspice, potpourri and incense. Lithe and sharply focused on the palate, offering juicy raspberry and redcurrant flavors that deepen and become sweeter with air. In a fresh, racy style that reminds me a lot of Chambolle-Musigny. Closes long, sweet and seamless, with just a whisper of tannins coming in late. – JR
