Most of the land was inherited from past generations of the Colin and Ponavoy families; certain parcels have been in the family for more than 100 years. While the family does own prime territory in Chassagne, home base in Saint-Aubin features parcels of the very best vineyards, En Remilly and Chatenière, to name a few. Today Caroline and Damien, two children of Marc and Michele, own and run the domaine.
