Samuel Billaud 2017 Chablis Fourneaux 1er Cru Chablis, France

The 2017 Chablis Fourneaux 1er Cru feels rather subdued after the Montmains and Vaillons, compact and laconic at present. The palate is very well balanced with a fine bead of acidity, taut and fresh with racy acidity towards the finish that seems eager to compensate for the aromatics. One to watch once in bottle. (NM)
