Dark red. Aromas of dried cherry, red currant, rose oil and botanical herbs are joined by an emerging hint of blood orange. Juicy and sharply focused on the palate, offering cherry and red berry flavors that show a hint of medicinal bitterness. Finishes tangy, taut and quite long, displaying resonating spiciness and a touch of candied flowers. In an Old World style, with no excess fat. (JR)
